 - CP0027 by Commissioner M. Hogan – A resolution proposing the creation of Section 19 of Article III and Section 6 of Article XI of the State Constitution to change the timing and increase the frequency of the establishment of future Taxation and Budget Reform Commissions.
 - CP0030 by the Governmental Services Committee – A resolution proposing an amendment to Section 1 of Article IX of the State Constitution to make the class size limitations applicable to school averages and to create limited flexibility in the number of students assigned to each teacher.
 - SR0038 by the Governmental Services Committee – An act relating to alternatives to incarceration requiring the Department of Corrections to include a plan, in the comprehensive correctional master plan, for contracting with local facilities and programs as short-term confinement resources for certain offenders whose net term of incarceration with the department is less than a specified period. Also authorizes the department to adopt rules permitting the extension of the limits of the place of confinement of inmates whose net term of incarceration with the department is less than a specified period.
 - CS/CP0040 by the Governmental Procedures and Structure Committee – A resolution proposing the creation of Section 27 of Article I of the State Constitution to authorize the Legislature to fund private or religious providers of public services, such as health care and education, and to authorize the public to choose among such service providers as permitted by law.
 - CS/CP0045 by Commissioner M. Hogan – A resolution proposing an amendment to Section 1 of Article VII and the creation of a new Section 19 of Article VII of the State Constitution to limit the growth of government spending.
